Paragraph about the story including the setting, characters, plot, theme **Recommendation**: Your opinion of the book.

You may do the book projects however you wish: <u>doc</u> (printed or <u>digital</u>), <u>google slides</u> (click on google slides for a google slide project template), , <u>smore</u>, <u>mysimpleshow</u>, <u>buncee</u>, poster, <u>padlet</u>, video, <u>OR</u> any way you want as long as it includes the above criteria.
