

Information For Class Officer Candidates

(Note the change from last year: No application is needed.
Follow the directions below to run for office.)

A list of candidates will be forwarded to all high school staff for any positive/negative input in lieu of paper recommendations. The feedback will be included in your eligibility to run for office.

You will be required to speak to your peers at a class meeting for about 3-4 minutes. Please use the criteria below to write your speech. Include your name and grade level.

What characteristics/qualifications do you feel you possess to become a class officer? How do you feel you can serve your class in a leadership position such as this? What experience have you had that will help shape your leadership skills? What vision do you have for your class? (fundraising, spirit week, class unity)

Speeches need to be sent to advisors no later than Thurs, May 20th or you will not be eligible to run for office.

Campaigning may start after May 20th.

A mandatory meeting with candidates and advisors will take place to go over expectations, responsibilities, and speech content on Tuesday, May 25th at 7:00 AM in the advisor’s classroom.

Class meetings to give speeches will take place on Friday, May 28th
1st period – Sophomores, 2nd period – Freshmen, and 6th period – Juniors
Voting will take place using Edu-Ballot and officers will be announced on June 3rd.
