## **Statistics:**

4 in 10 LGBT youth (42%) say the community in which they live is not accepting of LGBT people.

LGBT youth are twice as likely as their peers to say they have been physically assaulted, kicked or shoved at school.

26% of LGBT youth say their biggest problems are not feeling accepted by their family, trouble at school/bulling, and a fear of being out/open. 22% of non-LGBT youth say their biggest problems are trouble with classes, exams, and grades.

Roughly 73% of LGBT youth say they are more honest about themselves online than in the real world.

# **Terminology:**

Lesbian: A sexual orientation that describes a woman who is emotionally and sexually attracted to other women.

Gay: A sexual orientation that describes a person who is emotionally and sexually attracted to people of their own gender. It can be used regardless of gender identity, but is more commonly used to describe men.

Bisexual: A sexual orientation that describes a person who is emotionally and sexually attracted to people of their own gender and people of other genders.

Transgender: Describes a person whose gender identity and assigned sex at birth do not correspond.

## **Gender Pronouns:**

Respecting people's self-identification means using the gender pronoun that they most identify with.
