For each book (minimum 2) you must include:

Title and Author

Journal entries - as you read make **predictions, connections and/or reflections** - include **quotes** to support your entries . You need at least 3 entries.

Favorite Passage to share with other students during first week of school. You can bring the book in to class, make a copy of the page in the book, or take a picture of the book with your chromebook. You must include the **title** of the book, the **pages** and **why** you chose to share this passage with your group.

Paragraph about the story including the setting, characters, plot, theme

Recommendation: Your opinion of the book.
