Saturday, February 9, 9:30-11:30 a.m.

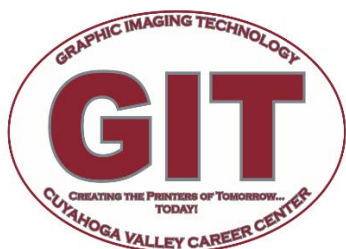
