State Budget Reductions (Part 1)

- March First signs that GRF revenues are eroding Schools closed March 16 due to (COVID-19) Coronavirus Pandemic
- April Tax receipts **BELOW** estimate by \$866.5M (35.3%); Year to date **BELOW** by \$777M Projected FY20 shortfall of \$2Billion by year end
- May FY20 budget reductions necessary; GRF reductions totaling \$775M

K – 12 Education (Foundation)	 \$300 Million
Medicaid	 \$210 Million
Higher Education	 \$110 Million
Other State Agencies	 \$100 Million
Other Education Budged Line Items	 \$55 Million

Foundation Funding

Foundation Funding to Traditional Districts (like ours) totals \$8.07 Billion in FY20 (current fiscal year)

State Funding reduced by \$300.5 Million (3.72%)

District payments will be reduced starting with May 22nd payment

Foundation Funding (continued)

Funding is reduced by an equalized per pupil amount

Per pupil reductions range from \$88.76 to \$304.32 Nordonia Hills per pupil reduction is \$289, 22.2% reduction in State funding effectively NOW


REDUCTION OF \$1,019,403 (2.16% of Total Revenue)

Rationale: Districts such as ours has a higher capacity to access resources locally (tax levies) and will see a higher per pupil reduction.
