Everyone Needs an FSA ID!

- ✓ This will serve as your legal signature on federal financial aid documents and the FAFSA.
- ✓ Go to <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>.
- ✓ Click on Create Account and create an FSA ID (federal student aid ID) for student <u>AND</u> anyone who is contributing to the FAFSA.
- ✓ You will need a permanent email and mobile-phone number.
- ✓ Create your FSA ID now, don't wait until December!

To be ready to complete the FAFSA as soon as it's available, consider the following steps:

- 1. Students should create a StudentAid.gov account
- 2. Learn about the documents they may need.
- 3. Determine their dependency status and whether their parent(s)will need to provide information.
- 4. If they are a dependent student, use the Who's MyFAFSAParent? wizard to identify the required contributors.

You are receiving this letter because you may have students who meet the eligibility requirements for a Hagan Scholarship who have not applied. All students in the high school graduating class can apply regardless of citizenship.

We have processed the fall applications, and it appears we will award over 600 new scholarships after finalist information is processed. An additional 600 scholarships can be awarded from the spring applications.

Selected Scholarship Criteria

- Must attend a high school located in the U.S.
- Must have achieved an unweighted 3.5 CGPA based on a 4.0 Grading Scale.
- Must enroll in a four-year college or university.
- Must work 240 hours from January 1, 2025 to September 1, 2025.
- Award recipients will receive \$2,000 to purchase essential items for college.
- Award recipients will be eligible to receive up to \$7,500 each semester.
- After graduation, eligible recipients can apply for a Hagan Graduate Scholarship.
- Application Deadline is March 15, 2025.
- Scholarships awarded in April, 2025.

Dear High School Guidance Counselor,

I am the Recruiting Operations Officer (ROO) at the University of Dayton Army Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC). I am writing to let you and your students know of the financial benefits of an Army ROTC High School Four-Year or Three-Year Advance Designee scholarship. Over the past year, we had 21 offers of the Army ROTC scholarships, either as a 4-Year scholarship or a 3-Year Advance Designee scholarship to incoming first year students to the University of Dayton. This was from a list of 61 applicants. Most had a choice of up to three schools and those who accepted UD this past fall received some additional incentives from the University of Dayton.

Each scholarship provides full tuition, \$1200 a year book allowance plus a \$420 subsistence allowance each year the scholarship is in effect.

1. The following incentives are offered for Four Year (full tuition valued at \$49,140 a year) scholarship winners: The University of Dayton will provide up to \$16,800 per year scholarship in addition to the Army ROTC Scholarship to cover room and board. Total annual benefit is over an average \$70,280 with a four year benefit of over \$285,000.

2. The following incentives are offered for Three Year Advance Designee Army ROTC Scholarship winners. The University of Dayton will apply your financial aid in year 1 based on their FAFSA scores, <u>BUT</u>, the University of Dayton will provide an amount of about \$16.800K toward room and board for the remaining four years. The total benefit of this package is over \$247,000.

The Army ROTC curriculum focuses on leadership development. This type of results oriented leadership is applicable to any career, military or civilian. We are looking for quality students in a scholar, athlete and leader (SAL) category and a propensity to serve their country in the Armed Forces.

I strongly encourage interested college bound students for the 2025 school year to apply for an Army ROTC four-year scholarship. Applications opened up for seniors on or about 12 June 2024 and can be completed on the Web at <u>www.goarmy.com/rotc</u> with a deadline of **4 March**, **2025**. The University of Dayton has an outstanding ROTC program that is well worth your consideration. There are over 275 schools that offer Army ROTC on campus and about 330 schools that partner with those schools. I am also available to conduct a school visit to meet with interested students either as a group or on an individual basis within about a 100 mile radius. The Foundation 649 Scholarship is a grant of \$4,000 over the course of 4 years that can be applied to college tuition and expenses. To maintain eligibility each year, there will be a brief check-in and renewal process at the end of each school year.

Details

- Five recipients will be selected
- Each recipient will receive an award of \$4,000 USD spread over 4 years
- The award must be renewed each year to receive successive funds (details to come)
- Application deadline is March I, 2025
- 10 entrants will be selected as finalists for video call interviews by March 3I, 2025
- Recipients are announced by April 15, 2025

Requirements

- Be a degree-seeking, full-time student enrolling in a U.S. accredited university in Fall 2025 as a Freshman or transferring from a community college
- Identify as Asian American / Pacific Islander
- Have a track record of involvement and interest in AAPI communities, issues, or causes
- Have demonstrated financial need for the scholarship
- Be a US citizen, resident or foreign national
- Application

The application consists of a questionnaire and a short essay (IOOO word maximum). Creativity is welcome - alternate media will also be accepted in place of the essay if the applicant chooses (e.g. film, photography, etc.). If you are selected as a recipient, with your permission, we plan to share your submission with our audiences.

In addition, applicants should provide the FAFSA SAR (student aid report) that show their EFC (expected family contribution). If you are unable to provide this document, please provide substitute documentation (W-2, 1099, or other tax documents) and elaborate in the financial aid
