To discuss the reopening of schools due to today's color level change in Summit County

Summit County COVID-19 level moved from red to yellow today (September 17). As a result, the board met in emergency session to discuss the next steps if the district stays in yellow on September 24.

The board discussed the need for one week to prepare to move from two days (hybrid model) to five days in person education.

The board moved if Summit County remains at the yellow level on September 24, all schools would begin five days a week beginning on Monday, September 28, 2020 with all students wearing masks unless they have a doctor's release. If the color level changes, the district would remain at the hybrid model of two days in school and three days on line and continue discussions at the September 28, 2020 board meeting.
