Forms

Required student forms are now available on the district website. Look under the category of "Families> District Forms" and you will find the link:

You will be able to log in with the account that you created last year and proceed to fill out all of the forms for your children. If you have multiple students in the district you do not need to make an account for each student. You can associate multiple students to one account. All parents with children coming into the district will need to create an account this year. You will need your student number to access these forms. *If you have forgotten your password for logging in, please click the "Forgot Username/Password" button.*

Schedule Distribution

All schedules will be posted in Progressbook starting August 17th at 2:30 p.m. for students to access. If a student would prefer a printed schedule, they may pick one up at the high school during normal business hours prior to the start of school or after August 18th.

Students are encouraged to make schedule changes with their counselor during their grade level window listed below. Students who are not able to come in during the grade-level window may also come to the high school during normal business hours to make a change starting August 20th after 8:00 a.m. Please understand that the counselor may not be immediately accessible outside of the schedule window for changes. It is recommended that students coordinate a time with the counselor beforehand if they cannot make the scheduled time for the student's grade level by calling the grade-level counselor at the number listed above.

Any scheduling conflicts will be addressed on a case by case basis before the first day of classes. Valid reasons to have a schedule change are insufficient credits, too many classes, missing courses, changes in acceptance to CVCC, CCP enrollment, summer course completion, etc. Reasons why a schedule will not be changed include: to change assigned teacher, to be in a class with a friend, to have 7th-period early release, to change an assigned lunch period, etc. Please call your grade-level counselor for an appointment to discuss questions or concerns.

Student Driving

All students with a valid driver's license and parent/guardian permission will be given an opportunity to register for student parking permits. Breakfast, Lunch, and the Daily Schedule

All students are eligible to receive one free breakfast and one free lunch again this school year. Extra items or second helpings are at the student's expense. The high school lunch price is \$3.25 and the breakfast price is \$2.50. All food is to be eaten in the cafeteria before school or during the lunch period.


The school day begins at 7:20 a.m. and dismisses at 2:11 p.m.
